



The following table is a rough guide to help you assess approximately how much footage you have and how long the actual running time is. Times will vary depending on the variable FPS of the original filming. When asking for a quotation please use this table as a guide.

Reel Diameter:	Film length:	Standard 8mm	Super 8
3 inch reel (76 mm)	50 ft	4 minutes	3.5 minutes
4 inch reel (101 mm)	100 ft	8 minutes	7 minutes
5 inch reel (127 mm)	200 ft	16 minutes	14 minutes
6 inch reel (152 mm)	300 ft	24 minutes	21 minutes
7 inch reel (177 mm)	400 ft	32 minutes	28 minutes

Please note:

Some 3" films from the Continent and New Zealand may contain between 60 -75 feet because some Fuji film was released on ultra thin film which fits 50% more on a 50 ft reel, i.e. 75 feet. Films marked 25 ft, are actually 50 ft when developed. They were double width and split into 2 single strips when developed. This type of film will be charged at the rate of its true length.

Film to DVD Conversion

Please ensure that the film is of reasonable quality and not requiring repair. Damaged film will not be processed by Coastlife Digital. While on site all film is securely stored in special light resistant aluminum film boxes.

All prices Quoted include digital conversion, DVD, case and Thermal Printing but exclude GST and Shipping if required.

Full color printing of DVD can be ordered at an extra price of \$5.00 per DVD. Extra DVDs can be duplicated at the price of \$7.50 including printing.

Delivery Time is typically 7 – 10 working days after collection of film stock.
